## Sleeping Arrangements

Camp groups will be established based on students' selections.

This is the time when we can all do with a little sugar! Chef provides cake and muffin options made from scratch with no pre-mixes.



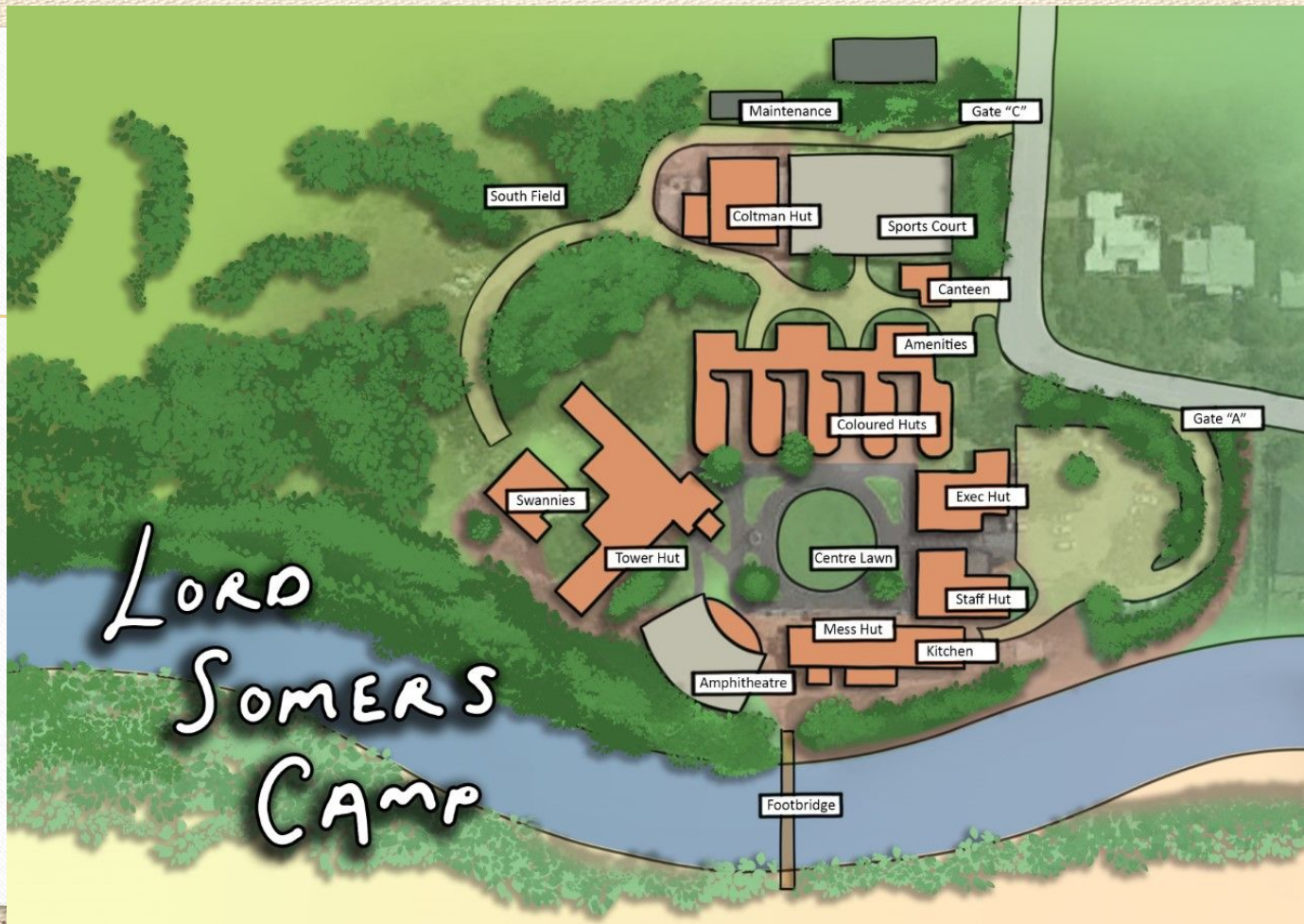
### Dinner: Sweet and Sour Chicken plus Rice with Steamed Vegetables

# What to Bring

## Suggested Packing List will be sent home:

#### Clothing: (Bring enough for one change of clothes per day)

- T-shirts / Long sleeve top
- Shorts / Pants
- Socks

## What not to Bring

## Communication

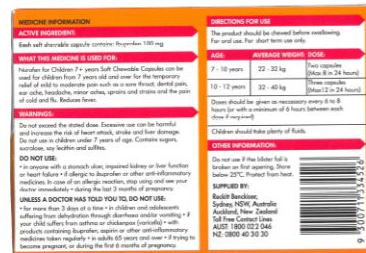
- If there is a need for any parent to be called, we will immediately call the school who will in turn call any relevant parents or nominated emergency contacts
- Any parents who need to contact the camp should call the school, who will call staff at the camp
- There will be a mobile number sent to parents to contact, in case of an emergency for outside school hours
- Staff will carry mobile phones at all times
- Students will not require mobile phones. If these are taken to camp they will be held onto by staff until students return to school
- To ensure all students have the greatest opportunity to participate effectively in the program the Student Code of Conduct (available on the school's website) will apply at all times. Any child not complying with the Code of Conduct will be returned to school and the cost of the camp forfeited



# Medical

- There will be a First Aid officer from KCPS at camp, alongside camp staff.
- KCPS will be providing Panadol, Nurofen, Claratyne and Zyrtec. A medical questionnaire including permission for staff to administer these will be part of the consent process on Compass
- Any students with **Asthma** will be required to fill out a School Camp Asthma form. This will be sent home with a Medication Authority form for other medication
- Any other medications will need to be provided to the students classroom teacher prior to the morning of camp

# Payment

- The camp will cost approximately **\$520.**
- **\$80** deposit is required to secure your child's place. This will be due on Compass by the **20/02/2026** this must be paid and/or consented by this date.
- The final balance will be due **27/03/2026**
- This year, payment plan options will be available to begin paying early. A letter has been attached on the compass event to organise the payment plan
- Use of CSEF/SSB money can be arranged through the front office.
- No refunds will be offered if your child is sent home from camp due to misconduct.

## Consent and Forms

- All medical, dietary and consent forms will be part of the consent/deposit process on COMPASS. When paying the deposit there will be a questionnaire for parents that must be filled out.
